

## The families with sexual abusive links

### **Abstract**

Every individual's ego, in terms of a natural creation, requires, in the formation of his or her subjectivity, the tolerance of Oedipal fantasies as normal by those who are in charge of his or her development as well as the relinquishment of those same fantasies in adults. Failing to take this lack into account leads to diagnostic and prognostic inadequacies. This paper proposes the Abusive Group concept and consequently the diagnosis of the child's psychic structure prior to exogenous sexual trauma. This prior structure forms the basis for the child's acceptance of the adult's abusive demands. The author proposes a differentiation in the use of the term "incest" to refer in generic terms to the psychic representation, using instead phenomenological forms such as "endogamic abuse" in the description of such a case. Given the interdisciplinary nature of the topic, some basic legal concepts are explained.
